National and state emergencies have been declared following the classification of COVID-19 as a pandemic. The Supreme Court of Missouri has suspended all in-person proceedings in all appellate and circuit courts- including all associate, family, juvenile, municipal and probate divisions through May 01, 2020. Subject to a few exceptions.

Due to Covid-19 pandemic Clarence Municipal Court will **NOT** be holding court in the month of April 2020. Citations dated for April 22, 2020 court date will be **rescheduled to July 22, 2020.**

If you would like to take care of your citation before your court date, you may submit your guilty plea and pay the fine and costs. Contact Clarence Municipal Court at 1-660-699-3310 if you need the amount due. You can also contact City Prosecutor Jim McConnell at 1-573-588-2115 for a recommendation on fines.
